MAD TOWN COUNCIL THANKS ANTONOVICH

How does one find the appropriate words to thank someone who has gone above and beyond what is expected of a County supervisor? We are talking TWENTY-FOUR years of total commitment to the Monrovia-Arcadia-Duarte County areas once dubbed "No Man's Land" because no one knew who to call when a problem arose. There was no Mayor or City Hall to contact.

That situation ended in June 1993, when the Monrovia-Arcadia-Duarte Town Council was sworn in by Supervisor Antonovich. It was no fluke or easy task. It began when a community meeting was called in December, 1992. Besides the Sheriff's Department, Field Deputy Sarah Flores attended, representing Antonovich. Subsequent meetings and an election process brought the Town Council to fruition.

As a founding member, I recall the first item on the agenda: a meeting with our three neighboring cities, orchestrated by the Supervisor, and he encouraged our working with them. He spearheaded the county purchase of Euclid Ave. property, Duarte; sixteen beautiful residences were built in conjunction with Habitat for Humanity. Council Member Carolyn Ziegler pursued the transit issue and all three areas continue to utilize Monrovia Transit. The Supervisor not only kept Pamela Park open, but brought us the beautiful new gymnasium, cheerleading uniforms one year, the annual beach bus and much more. Who has not enjoyed those annual family concerts at the Arboretum?

As a human being, I greatly admire the

Supervisor because he is the champion of children, Senior citizens, Veterans and even animals. He has worked diligently with the foster care system. Every year he held that awesome Veterans Fair with entertainment and many booths providing services and information for Veterans and their families. He encouraged adoption of cats and dogs too.

A few days ago, I pulled out a huge binder with "letters" from my first Town Council years. I was flabbergasted at the amount I received from the Supervisor on matters he could address-such as Pamela Park, and letters from various county heads whom HE had contacted to assist me. A few include: Harry Stone, Public Works-a private road not eligible for county paving, but pot holes on Lincoln would be filled; Rodney Cooper, Parks and Recreation-addressed bathroom stall issue; Richard DeRock, Access Services and Julian Burke regarding MTA Bus Lifts and purchase of bus passes. During the Supervisor's terms of office, a stop sign FINALLY was installed at Daines/Tyler Avenues, Arcadia, more curbs painted red on Longden Ave. to prevent a tragedy at the Arcadia Ball Field, the great new street signs and THANK YOU SUPERVISOR for the new Live Oak Library FINALLY in the works!

I could go on and on and tell of assistance I received from the Supervisor even when I was no longer on the Town Council. I just want to THANK him on behalf of the entire Monrovia-Arcadia-Duarte Town Council and all its residents for what he has done for us over the years. He never stopped caring.

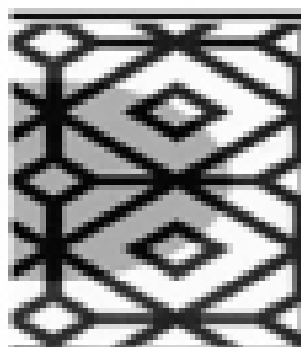

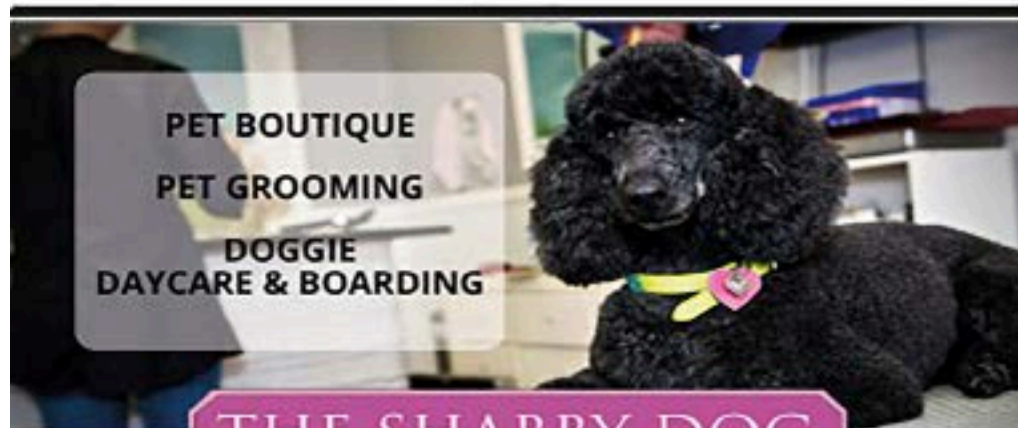

HOW THESE COMMON ASSETS CAN AFFECT YOUR FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY

Financial aid is a valuable resource for students and their families. And a child going off to college is one of life's biggest events. Unfortunately, certain assets you acquire may adversely affect student financial aid eligibility. That's why careful financial planning is particularly important for families with college age children.

Federal financial aid eligibility is calculated using many variables, parental income and assets being some of the most important. Income and assets can increase the EFC, or Expected Family Contribution. The EFC is a measure of the family's ability to pay for college. But strategic financial planning can help you save funds for college without increasing your EFC

and reducing your child's financial aid eligibility. Let's look at the ways some common assets affect financial aid eligibility.

Retirement Accounts: 401(k)s, and Roth and traditional IRAs are not used to determine your EFC. However, funds withdrawn from these accounts, even if used for college expenses, are counted as income and thus can affect your EFC.

Home Equity: Federal financial aid calculations do not include equity in the parents' primary residence. Individual institutions, however, may include equity when determining aid eligibility.

UGMA/UTMA accounts: These can be considered either the parents' or the student's asset, depending on how the account is titled and who is named as beneficiary.

Family Owned Businesses: The value of small family owned businesses is not included in the federal aid calculation, if at least 50% is owned and controlled by the family, and it has less than 100 employees.

Life Insurance Policies and Annuities: The cash values of these assets are not included in the federal aid calculation.

Mutual Funds: The value of mutual funds is considered an asset, while distributions and capital gains are considered income. This is an important distinction because the portion of income that can be included in the federal aid calculation is much more than the portion of assets that can be included.

529 Savings Accounts and Coverdell ESAs: These are typically considered assets of the parents. Withdrawals are not included, unless coming from a third-party account, such as a grandparent's.

As you can see, planning for college requires you consider many factors, such as which assets can affect financial aid and just how they do so. You can maximize your student's financial aid eligibility, however, by developing a financial plan that will allow you to take advantage of asset exclusions when filing the FAFSA. After all, preserving assets is a key component to successful estate planning.

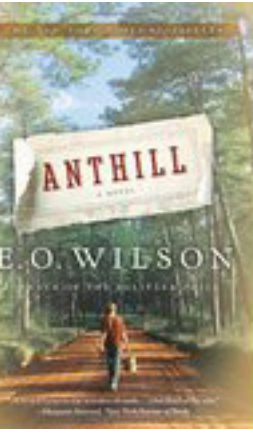

A staggering 85% of millennials own smartphones, making them the largest generational group in the USA to own a smart device. 87 percent of American Millennials say their smartphone never leaves their side. Millennials have reported feeling increasingly depressed and anxious due to smartphone use. The fear of missing out (FOMO) and the need to check their phones compulsively are also commonly reported side effects of the same. Millennials are also annoyed by the amount of time they spend on smartphones. One study reported that M's check their phones as much as 167 times a day. They also don't like the pressure to consistently document their lives, as well as security concerns with regard to stolen data and other security variables. 82% of millennials check their smartphones within an hour of getting up. 38% of millennials have taken a call while driving, only 25% of them have a hands-free set.. 43% of millennials can't go to the toilet without their smartphone, with full-time employees and men being the most affected. One in three millennials checks their phones right after sex while twice as many men than

women have checked their phones during sex. Contrary to popular belief, the large majority of millennials (64%) neither sexts or send naked selfies. More than half of all millennials now only browse the internet on their smartphones, what's more - among teenagers, it's 91%. To be fair, millennials have many compelling reasons for using their smartphones: Experian data show that roughly one in five millennials (again, more than other age groups) use their phones to read the news during a typical week, and millennials are more likely than other cohort to use their phones to stay in touch with friends. What's more, Pew data shows that millennials are more likely than other groups to use their phones to look at educational content, find and apply for jobs and learn more about a health condition. For the rest of us: The majority (89 per cent) of Americans check their smartphones "at least a few times a day," while 36 per cent admit they are "constantly checking and using" their phones, some can't go longer than a few minutes and others can last longer than 24 hours without checking. No doubt Smartphone use is highly addictive.

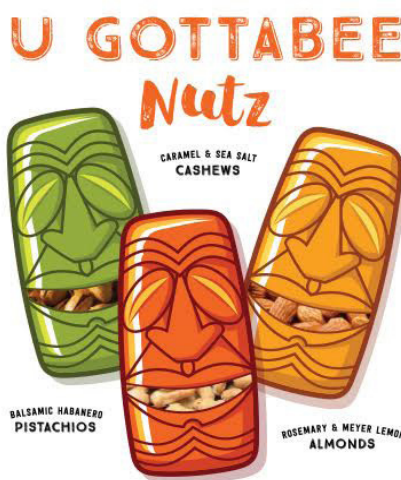

BUBBLES ARE IN SEASON

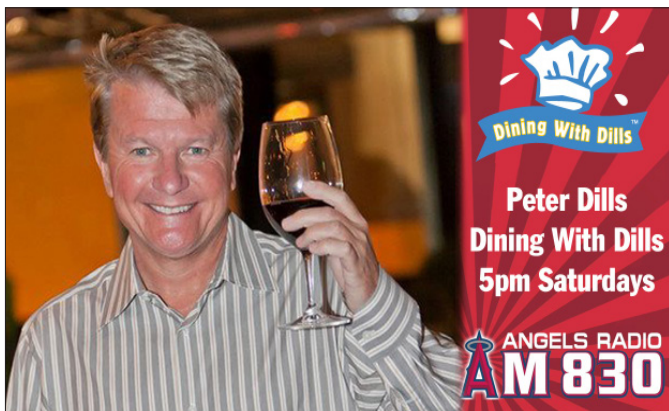

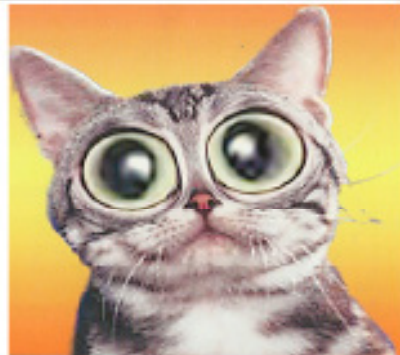

The holiday season seems to bring out the best in the those of us who enjoy cooking and conjuring up unique recipes to prepare and share with family and friends. These days, that "somethin lovin" that comes from the oven often includes healthy, hand-crafted home-made treats prepared for pets by the jolly chef, to show particular appreciation to their canine companions at Christmastime.

A few years ago I received a beautiful bundle of holiday goodies from a dear friend and fellow dog-lover. Inside the package was an amazing assortment of tasty goods for me and the hubby to enjoy but it also included a bag of home-baked dog biscuits for my girls, Tater and Molly. Well, I must say they loved her for it! I also thought it was a great gift idea, so I decided to try baking a few dog treats of my own to give away in the spirit of the holiday season.

The concept of cooking home-made eatables for my pets has always interested me because I know if I am preparing it, I can control what goes into it and I like to select healthy, nutritious ingredients that are good for their particular needs.

I had never baked snacks or treats for my dogs before, so I made my first attempt soon after realizing how much my girls enjoyed that gift basket we had recently received. To help get the ball rolling I called on a few friends to see if they had any tried & true recipes they'd used and would like to recommend.

Among the canine cookie concoctions I collected, my attention was drawn particularly to a couple given to me by one of my clients. She occasionally bakes for her awesome foursome as I like to call her beautiful brood of four small dogs, all of whom enjoy the home-baked treats she prepares and keeps for them in a cookie jar on the kitchen counter.

During my visits to her home, I've noticed the dogs showing interest in the cookie jar, and they seem to know those treats are to be given on special occasions only. Now and then they'll appeal to me for a little something from of the loving jar, and I am happy to oblige, now and then! Believe me, being catered to is nothing new for that four-legged crew, but this doggie-ma says her pups like bones baked at home far more than those she brings home from the store.

Here are the recipes my dear friend/client shared with me. While home-made treats may require a little time and effort, I do believe our pets are worth it. I encourage all my pup-owning pals to try one or both of these recipes. And if you do, I hope you'll enjoy making use of them. Be careful not to use ingredients that may not agree with your pup's palate - particularly where food allergies are of concern. I found lots of recipes on line, many designed for dogs with special dietary needs, so there's sure to be something there to fit your pet.

Happy Holidays to all you animal lovers out there, and bon appetite to your beloved canine companions!

DELICIOUS DOG BISCUITS

Source: *Gourmet* / December 2005

Ingredients: 3 1/2 cups whole-wheat flour, 1 3/4 cups cornmeal, 1 3/4 cups old-fashioned rolled oats, 1/2 cup toasted wheat germ, 1/2 cup packed light brown sugar, 1 tsp baking powder, 1 1/2 tsp salt, 3/4 cups cold, unsalted butter cut into tbsp. size pieces, 1 cup, plus 1 tbsp water, 1/2 cup fresh flat-leaf parsley, 1/2 cup chopped fresh mint leaves, 1 large egg

Special Equipment: A pastry or bench scraper and a bone-shaped dog biscuit cookie cutter

Directions: Pulse flours, cornmeal, oats, wheat germ, brown sugar, baking powder and in salt in a food processor until evenly combined. Add butter and pulse until mixture resembles coarse meal with pea-size butter lumps. Add 1 cup water and pulse until a coarse, dense dough forms.

Turn out onto a lightly floured surface and knead in parsley and mint until well distributed.

Gather, then halve dough with scraper. Form into 2 balls and flatten each into a 6-inch disk.

Put oven racks in upper and lower thirds of oven and preheat to 350 degrees F.

Roll out 1 disk of dough into a round (1/3 inch thick) on a well-floured surface with a rolling pin. (If dough becomes too soft to roll out, wrap in plastic and chill until firm.) Cut out as many biscuits as possible and arrange about 1/4 inch apart on a baking sheet.

Gather scraps and re-roll, then cut out more biscuits. Repeat with remaining dough using another baking sheet.

Whisk together egg and 1 tbsp water. Brush biscuits with egg wash and bake, switching position of sheets halfway through, until tops are golden brown, about 35 minutes total. Turn off oven and dry biscuits overnight.

* Biscuits keep about 1 month, layered between sheets of wax paper or parchment in an airtight container.

SIMPLE SIMON'S BIRTHDAY BONES

Ingredients: 2 cups whole wheat flour, 1 tbsp baking powder, 1 cup natural peanut butter, 1 cup skim milk

Directions: Pre-heat oven to 375 degrees.

Combine flour and baking powder.

In a separate bowl, combine peanut butter and milk.

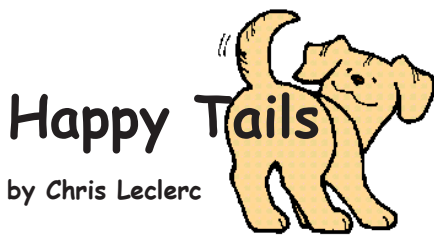
Add wet mixture to dry and mix well.

The purpose of the MCTA is to achieve compliance with Senate Bill No. 1069 (SB 1069), which expands a property owner or developer's ability to build a second residential dwelling unit on their property and simultaneously restricts discretionary and regulatory authority over such development by introducing new development standards, including allowable floor area, garage conversion requirements, setback provisions, rental restrictions, fire sprinkler requirements, and utility connections. The Planning Commission recommended that the City Council approve MCTA 16-04 and adopt Urgency Ordinance 1383-U.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: An Initial Study was prepared for the 2008-2014 Housing Element in accordance with the City's guidelines implementing the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This Initial Study was undertaken for the purpose of deciding whether the measures identified in the Housing Element to fulfill the City's RHNA allocation may have a significant effect on the environment. On the basis of the Initial Study, City staff concluded that they will not have a significant effect on the environment, and a Negative Declaration was adopted by City Council on June 11, 2013.
