## SIERRA MADRE PLAYHOUSE ANNOUNCES SHOWS FOR 2020 SEASON

Sierra Madre Playhouse plans four mainstage productions for its 2020 season. Two plays are return engagements of audience favorites. The other two are productions of works that are new to the Playhouse. The schedule is as follows:

March 30- May 1, 2020: *Charlotte's Web*. Adapted for the stage by Joseph Robinette. Based on the story by E.B. White. *Charlotte's Web* is the famed story of a spider who engages in web-weaving miracles to rescue her friend, Wilbur the pig, from a horrible death at a butcher's knife. Instead, Wilbur goes on to become admired and famous in his surrounding community. Wilbur, in return, acts to ensure the survival of Charlotte's children. It's a sweet, simple but powerful tale of the value and importance of friendship. Though it will obviously resonate with young audiences, it is intelligent enough to hold the interest of adult theater-goers as well.

June 20- August 2: *King of the Yees*. By Lauren Yee. Take any Chinese last name, and there exists a corresponding family association with branches in each major American city, Chinese American men's clubs formed over a hundred years ago. For nearly twenty years, playwright Lauren Yee's father Larry has been a driving force in the Yee Family Association. Until now. Amid a backdrop of crumbling Chinatowns and all-too-lifelike museums, Lauren races through history, space, and the fourth wall to find her father in this joyride through San Francisco's disappearing past.

September 5- October 11: *Silent Sky* by Lauren Gunderson. When Henrietta Leavitt begins work at the Harvard Observatory in the early 1900s, she isn't allowed to touch a telescope or express an original idea. Instead, she joins a group of women computers, charting the stars for a renowned astronomer who calculates projects in girl hours and has no time for the women's probing theories. As Henrietta, in her free time, attempts to measure the light and distance of stars, she must also take measure of her life on Earth, trying to balance her dedication to science with family obligations and the possibility of love. The true story of 19th-century astronomer Henrietta Leavitt explores a woman's place in society during a time of immense scientific discoveries, when women's ideas were dismissed until men claimed credit for them. Social progress, like scientific progress, can be hard to see when one is trapped among earthly complications; Henrietta Leavitt and her female peers believe in both, and their dedication changed the way we understand both the heavens and Earth.

November 28- December 27: *A Christmas Story*. Adapted for the stage by Philip Grecian. Based on the screenplay by Jean Shepherd, Leigh Brown and Bob Clark and on the book *In God We Trust, All Others Pay Cash* by Jean Shepherd. Directed by Christian Lebrano. In this Christmas adventure like no other, a boy's ardent campaign for a Red Ryder BB gun against all odds ("You'll shoot your eye out!") unfolds amid seasonal shenanigans involving a leg lamp, a bunny suit and a tongue stuck on a frozen flagpole. Relive a family tradition or start one anew by joining Ralphie and his family for this stage adaption of the beloved film inspired by Jean Shepherd's classic American story of Christmas-and growing up-in the Midwest.

**THROUGHOUT THE YEAR:** The last Monday of every month except November and December, the Playhouse presents *Off the Page*, a series of staged readings of plays of interest that may be considered for future production. (*Silent Sky* was originally presented as a reading in this series.)

Also, our *Off the Screen* series presents midweek presentations of films including screen classics and a few silent films, most of them related to themes presented in our live stage productions. A film historian is present at each screening to provide fascinating facts and contexts for each film.

Tickets for most live stage presentations range from \$25 to \$45. Admission for most film screenings is \$10.

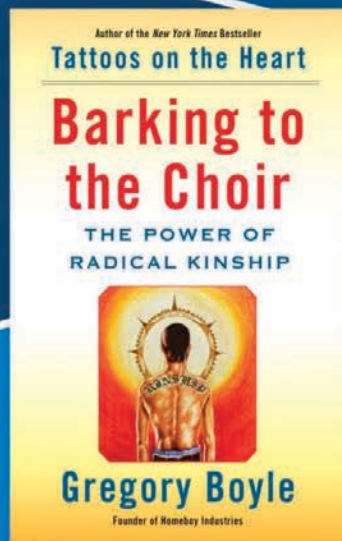

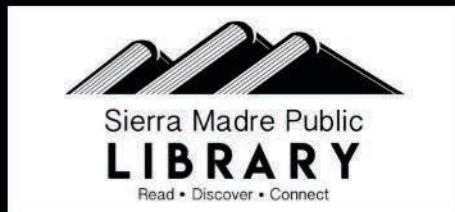

### “EMPIRE OF THE ANTS!”



You don't know how guilty I feel recycling articles two weeks in a row. Such blatant failure to live up to my 2019 New Years resolution of not doing that. But I'm only human.

I considered recycling the one I wrote about re-gifting etiquette, but then you'd expect something like that around

Christmas. So why not read about a great sci fi cinematic gem from 1977 starring Joan Collins versus giant, mutant ants!

"Empire of the Ants" begins with anonymous "government agents" dumping barrels of radioactive waste, conveniently labeled "Radioactive Waste: Danger! Hazardous! [Skull & Crossbones]" into the ocean. They wash ashore and ooze mercury-colored liquid that's quickly consumed by the resident ants.

Cut to Joan Collins as a crooked realtor trying to sell worthless property in the Florida everglades under the premise that the adjacent land will soon be developed as a resort town. The majority of her potential buyer-victims are equally shady.

We get snapshots of their character flaws during the boat ride and bus tour around the properties. One philandering man abandons his wife to hit on another female passenger. A women broke up with the man who was cheating on his wife with her, and now she's using his hush money to buy real estate. An older couple shamelessly admit to having no intention whatsoever of buying anything, and are just here for the free food and boat ride. Lovely.

What's most striking during all of this is the gratuitous sexual references and overly raunchy language. "This is 1977!" I thought. My parents got married that year! People back then weren't the crude animals they are today. Or at least the movies weren't as crass, or so I thought. But after about 15 minutes the language improved and the innuendo stopped. I guess the director figured he had the audience hooked by then.

So while the humans are busy trying to rip each other off and commit other nefarious acts, the ants, now grown to gargantuan size after their radioactive cocktail, have been tirelessly working away at the everglades, creating barriers among the forests, and dams in the river.

Eventually the humans happen upon the ants, and start getting picked off, one or two at a time. Like all great cheesy sci-fi horror flicks, the victim either trips and unexplainably can't get up, or gets cornered somewhere while their oversized, slow-moving predator runs them at a snail's pace --amid much screaming.

Predictably, their group gets split up, making self defense all the more difficult. While they're separated, the creep who tried to pick up the girl lets his wife get eaten. When he rejoins the group he launches into a rant about how the others are blaming him for the death of his wife, whom he claims he tried to save. Next time their boat is attacked by ants, they go for him. The ants know which ones are jerks.

Meanwhile, the old couple hide in an abandoned shack. They think they've waited out the danger, only to open the door and discover that they're surrounded. Of all the bad acting in this movie I think this scene takes the cake! The couple stand next to each other ("clutch" is too strong a word) and lethargically scan from side to side at the oversized ants with unfocused stares, their expressions something between dazed confusion and heart burn. Needless to say, the ants make quick work out of them.

The little band of survivors reach civilization, only to realize that something's "off" about the locals' behavior. They get captured and taken to an ominous-looking sugar processing plant. There, they're forced into a queue with other zombie-like individuals, helplessly making their way toward an air tight chamber housing the queen ant, who emits a cloud of pheromones to each victim in turn.

The pheromones alter one's state of mind, causing them to bend their will to serve the ants, namely, supplying them with an endless amount of sugar from the factory. Joan Collins is the first to go, but even her fellow prisoners don't care. No one liked her anyway.

Meanwhile, the hero (if you can call him that) breaks free, starts dousing the place with gasoline, then sets it ablaze. He rescues the others and they sail away on a dingy through the winding rivers of the everglades. Dampening their victory is the nagging suspicion that the next town, and perhaps the whole country is under the sway of the Empire of the Ants.

Great stuff! You've gotta' check it out, if only to laugh at some bad acting, bad special effects, and bad fashion from the 70's. And while you're at it, check out my novel, "A Year at Apex!" Humor, romance, and the human condition rolled into a bite sized package. Look for it in paperback and ebook on Amazon and Barnes & Noble.

The Switzer pumpkins haven't happened for quite a few years now, but the party they started goes on. We hold Bud and the rest of the family in our thoughts and prayers.

“That First Noel's come 'round again,

Just like it does each year,

To tell us it's Christmas, finally it's Christmas,

Joyfully it's Christmas,

The best time of the year, the best time of the year...”

This particular song goes on to tell us that the tree is in the window, the wreath is on the door, and about a million ornaments are scattered on the floor! Most probably you're way past that stage, the tree is up and gorgeous. You finally untangled the lights and put the angel up on top. But here's the question you'll be facing in a few days when the presents are all unwrapped and everything you got everybody was exactly what they wanted: Why is it that putting up Christmas decorations is so much more fun than taking them down? Also, why is it that the Christmas decorations that seem so few and so light as you take them out of the plastic crates have doubled (like wire hangers) in size and tripled in weight and you can't remember when on earth you carried all those to the living room.



Playing Christmas music and rediscovering each cute little Christmas item is such fun and then deciding where to put each one is a pleasure. I'm especially partial to all my little lighted houses. My mother started collecting them many years ago and gave her collection to me. I have added to it over the years and now think I have about twenty of them. They look fantastic on top of the bookcases, and the tall cabinet. The most interesting part of putting these things up is, of course, not falling off the small ladder. The second most interesting thing is figuring out how to get them all plugged in somewhere. The ones on top of the bookcase in my office even turn on and off with the wall switch, which is fabulous.

Every Christmas I am reminded of Santa's Band, which was John's favorite Christmas decoration. Many years ago he went to Costco and came home with his eyes alight and excitement spilling out of his every word as he described this wonderful band of little musicians attached to bells and electrically driven so every time you turned it on, it played a Christmas carol. They had quite a repertoire and the band was led, of course, by Santa. John went to Costco several times and came home each time with more stories of the glories of Santa's Band. I finally took his hand, looked deep into his eyes and said, "You know, honey, you can buy Santa's Band yourself, with your own money!" He had never thought of that. Back he went and Santa's Band decorated the top of one of our bookcases every year from then on. Yes, it got up there after I spent an hour untangling all the wires, bells and little people, but he loved it. Apparently, all the children loved it, too, and there was lively discussion over who should have Santa's Band. Our daughter, Patti, ended up with it and I was happy to hand it over and let her untangle all those wires and bells.

We all have special nostalgic goodies that fill our hearts with memories and happy thoughts. We had just a few things to put on it, but it was our tree and our home and our children opened presents under it and I will remember always what a wonderful time that was.

My Christmas tree now is an artificial one from Michael's, prelit, which is another genius idea. Not having to put lights on the tree makes my Christmas way merrier. It looks great and the picture is this tree.

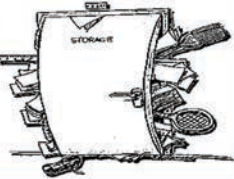

## City Issues Christmas Safety Tips

Although Christmas tree fires are rare, they are very serious when they do occur. According to the U.S. Fire Administration, one-third of home Christmas tree fires are caused by electrical problems and one-quarter start when the tree is placed too close to a heat source, such as a fireplace, woodstove, radiator or space heater.

It's important to place your tree at least three feet away from heat sources, and make sure you don't block room exits in case of emergency. Consider using a timer so you don't forget to turn off the lights at night.

**Selecting a Tree:** Natural trees should be given a fresh cut at the base and placed immediately in water. When purchasing a tree, buy one that is as fresh as possible. Tap the butt of the tree on the ground a couple of times, grab a branch near the top, and pull your hand along it slowly. Needles should not fall off. If you bend a needle and it breaks before bending in half, it's too dry! If you use an artificial tree, select one with a flame retardant label.

**Caring for the Tree:** Make a fresh cut an inch or two off the bottom before placing it in the stand. This will help with absorption. Water a live tree every day. When the tree becomes dry, discard it promptly.

**Placing the Tree:** Place your tree in a non-tip style holder with wide feet, using extra wires if needed to keep it steady. Keep doorways and exits clear. Place your tree and decorations away from heaters, fireplaces, candles, and other sources of heat.

**Decorating the Tree:** Consider switching to new LED lights that are cooler and use less electricity. Before bringing out the older lights, inspect for frayed wires or other defects. Make sure the bulbs themselves are not touching the tree, curtains, wrapped gifts, and tree skirts. Never use lighted candles as decorations. Turn off the lights when leaving the house or going to bed for the night.

**Outdoor Decorations**  
The State Fire Marshal offers these tips for safe use of outdoor lights:  
Use lights rated for outdoor use only.  
Check and make sure wires are not frayed to allow water to seep inside.  
Consider replacing older outdoor lights with newer LED lights that are 'greener' and cooler.

Securely anchor outdoor lights and decorations against the wind and storms with insulated holders or hooks. Use electrical connection protectors to keep water out. All outdoor electrical decorations should be plugged into a ground-fault circuit interrupter (GFCI). You can buy portable units for outdoor use, or you can have them permanently installed by an electrician. Don't overload circuits. 15 amp circuits support 1,800 watts and 20 amp circuits support 2,400 watts. Do not drive nails, staples or tacks through wiring insulation; this can cause a fire.

Bring outdoor electrical lights inside after the holidays to prevent hazards and extend their life.

Be sure that your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are in good working order.

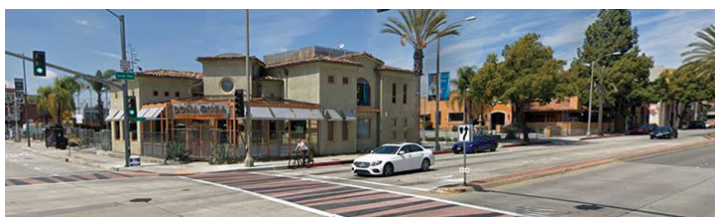


## New South Arroyo Parkway Development

The Pasadena city council will be briefed Monday night, for the first time, regarding a new large 3.3-acre, eight-story, development plan for five lots, 491 to 577, South Arroyo Parkway and incorporate part of Whole Foods Market.

According to a city staff report, the proposed project, by Arroyo Parkway, LLC, "consists of the retention of three existing buildings, partial demolition of existing buildings, and the establishment of a new Planned Development (PO) zoning district and a new PO Plan. The PO Plan would facilitate the construction of a 150,000 square-foot, seven-story, medical office building and a 180,000 square-foot, eight-story, assisted living facility. The PO Plan would incorporate an existing 91,145 square-foot Food Sales use (Whole Foods) as part of the project. 604 new parking spaces would be provided. The project site is within the CD-6 (Central District, Arroyo Corridor/ Fair Oaks subdistrict) zoning district. The applicant is proposing to establish a Planned Development zone for the 3.3 acre project site."

Also according to the staff report, "the project proposes the retention and reuse of two existing commercial structures (501 and 523 S.



Arroyo Parkway). The Design & Historic Preservation Section has determined that these structures are eligible for landmark designation. It has been indicated to staff that a Variance for Historic Resources will be requested by the applicant, as part of the entitlement, to allow a greater height than the established 50' maximum for the site. As part of the Variance for Historic Resources application, documentation would need to be submitted that identifies how the project meets the purposes and findings specified for the Variance as follows:

a. The Variance for Historic Resource is necessary to facilitate the appropriate use of an existing designated historic structure; b. The Variance for Historic Resource would not adversely impact property within the neighborhood or historic district; and c. Granting the Variance for Historic Resource application would be in conformance with the goals,

policies, and objectives of the General Plan and the purpose and intent of any applicable specific plan."

Staff said the report is only intended to provide information to the city council and no action or vote will be taken. There will be an opportunity for public comment during the meeting.

The council meets at 6:30 p.m. Council Chamber, Pasadena City Hall 100 North Garfield Avenue, Room S249.

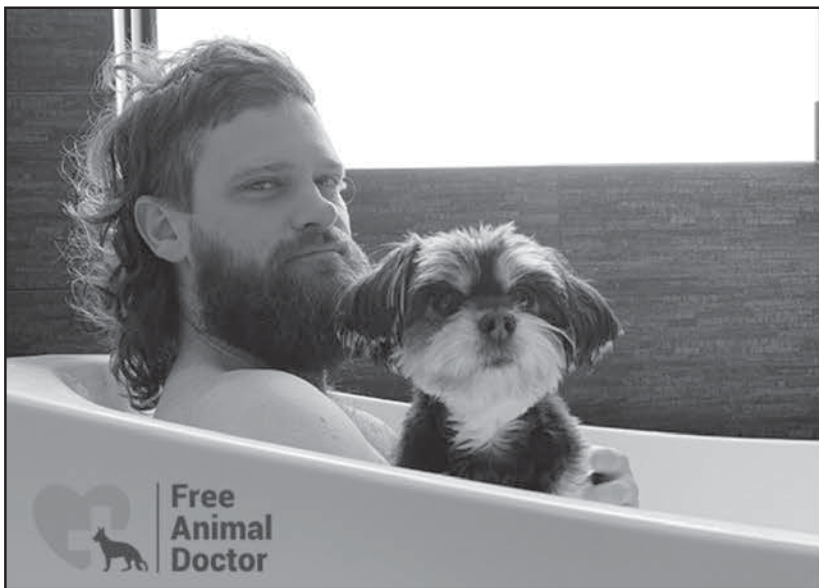

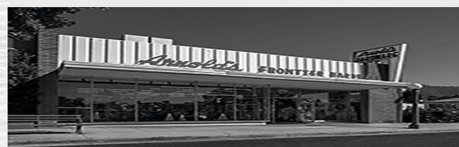

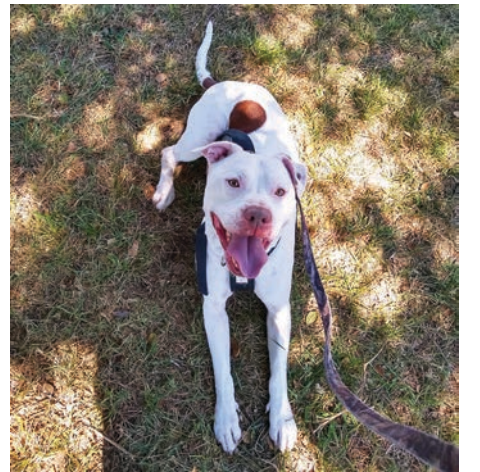

## WHY THE RISK OF HEART ATTACK RISES IN WINTER

Dear Savvy Senior:

I've read that people with heart problems need to be extra careful during the winter months because heart attacks are much more common. Why is this?

Cautious Senior

Dear Cautious:

Everyone knows winter is cold and flu season, but many don't know that it's also the prime season for heart attacks too, especially if you already have heart disease or have suffered a previous heart attack. Here's what you should know, along with some tips to help you protect yourself.



In the U.S., the risk of having a heart attack during the winter months is twice as high as it is during the summertime. Why? There are a number of factors, and they're not all linked to cold weather. Even people who live in warm climates have an increased risk. Here are the areas you need to pay extra attention to this winter

**Cold temperatures:** When a person gets cold, the body responds by constricting the blood vessels to help the body maintain heat. This causes blood pressure to go up and makes the heart work harder. Cold temperatures can also increase levels of certain proteins that can thicken the blood and increase the risk for blood clots. So, stay warm this winter, and when you do have to go outside, make sure you bundle up in layers with gloves and a hat, and place a scarf over your mouth and nose to warm up the air before you breathe it in.

**Snow shoveling:** Studies have shown that heart attack rates jump dramatically in the first few days after a major snowstorm, usually a result of snow shoveling. Shoveling snow is a very strenuous activity that raises blood pressure and stresses the heart. Combine those factors with the cold temperatures and the risks for heart attack surges. If your sidewalk or driveway needs shoveling this winter, hire a kid from the neighborhood to do it for you, or use a snow blower. Or, if you must shovel, push rather than lift the snow as much as possible, stay warm, and take frequent breaks.

**New Year's resolutions:** Every Jan. 1, millions of people join gyms or start exercise programs as part of their New Year's resolution to get in shape, and many overexert themselves too soon. If you're starting a new exercise program this winter, take the time to talk to your doctor about what types and how much exercise may be appropriate for you.

**Winter weight gain:** People tend to eat and drink more and gain more weight during the holiday season and winter months, all of which are hard on the heart and risky for someone with heart disease. So, keep a watchful eye on your diet this winter and avoid binging on fatty foods and alcohol.

**Shorter days:** Less daylight in the winter months can cause many people to develop "seasonal affective disorder" or SAD, a wintertime depression that can stress the heart. Studies have also looked at heart attack patients and found they usually have lower levels of vitamin D (which comes from sunlight) than people with healthy hearts. To boost your vitamin D this winter, consider taking a supplement that contains between 1,000 and 2,000 international units (IU) per day.

**Flu season:** Studies show that people who get flu shots have a lower heart attack risk. It's known that the inflammatory reaction set off by a flu infection can increase blood clotting which can lead to heart attacks in vulnerable people. So, if you haven't already done so this year, get a flu shot for protection. And, if you've never been vaccinated for pneumococcal pneumonia, you should consider getting these two shots (given 12 months apart) too.

## WHERE DOES SANTA GET HIS NAUGHTY OR NICE LIST?

If I do not understand her question, my answer is going to get me into trouble. Believe me; I know what trouble is all about.

Most of them are somewhat antsy and try to stay out of trouble as much as possible. I can certainly relate to that.

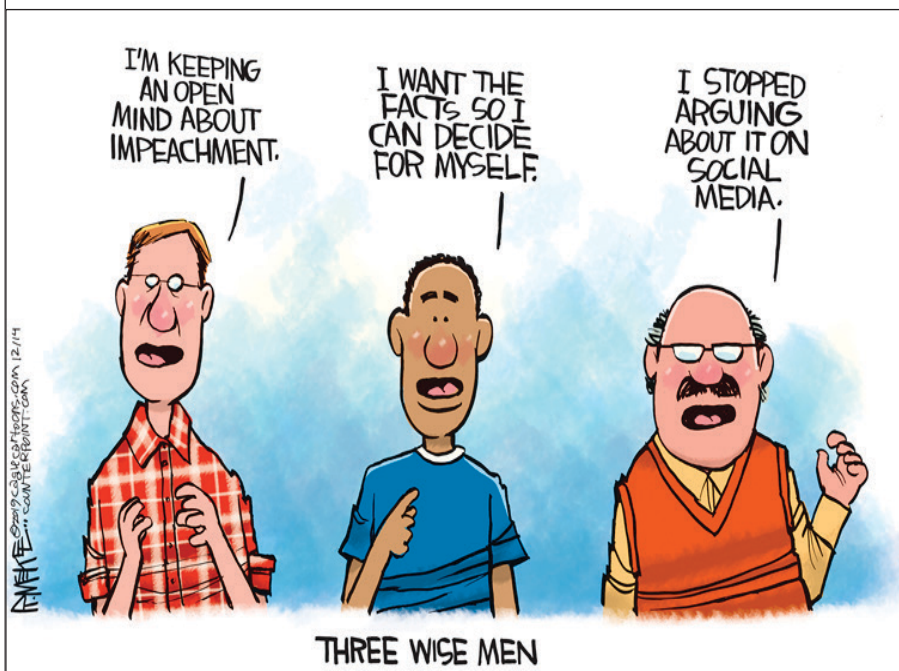
It is time to let Trump know that he sits in the office at the pleasure of the people. He's had plenty of time to learn on the job, but there's no indication that he's trying to learn.

### TRUTH OR WHAT PASSES FOR IT

If you hear somebody say something about something factual do you believe it or think the person is lying. This is an irritatingly frequently asked question today as our political parties are seemingly in the business of presenting the public with completely different versions of what they each claim to be the truth. Who are we to believe? Certainly, one would think that evolution, over many millions of years, should have favored people with the ability to pick up subtle signs of deception that would aid their ability to survive; but according to Malcolm Gladwell writing in his book Never Talk To Strangers it doesn't work that way. He cites multiple scientific studies supporting his position and it is very difficult to disbelieve him.

On NPR this morning I heard a discussion describing the ill effects to the public when they are not able to believe what they are hearing. Consequences of prolonged confusion, drug use and depression were described as predictable consequences, I don't know if I believe that because it is a prediction rather than a statement of fact; but the prediction does fall right in line with what Gladwell describes as the Social-Scientist Ted Levine's Truth-Default -Theory or TDT. Basically Levine's theory boils down to the fact that it is a lot easier to believe than to disbelieve. To believe a person is simple. You hear what they say and accept it as truth. To disbelieve is stressful—why is the person not telling the truth? Are they trying to manipulate me in some way? Are they trying to hurt me and convince me to do something I don't want to do?

If you think about any and all advertising or marketing, that is what is being done to you. The friendly smiling spokesmen on TV are not presenting factual information to you for their health—they are trying to sell you something. It is trade, commerce and easily managed consumers that is the backbone of our particular system. Even though we know we are always being lied to there is not much we can do about it other than endure the stress of continual disbelief and determine that everyone is lying all the time. The consequences of that kind of permanent disbelief may be the behind the scenes cause of our chaotic political system today where untold millions of dollars are spent disseminating obvious untruths in the belief (probably a correct one) that if lies are repeated frequently enough they will be believed.

Nothing I have said so far is probably new to you but today I have a personal reason for talking about our attitude toward truth. Many of you know that I have been a practicing lawyer for over fifty years and undoubtedly, some of you are familiar with the Shakespearean quote "The first thing we do, let's kill all the lawyers." You might think I am offended by that quote but I am not because I believe I understand its intent and, in fact, mentioned the quote when I used to lecture on ethics. I use the quote to illustrate the function of lawyers; to be at war with the expressed truth of their enemy. You probably are unaware that the overarching obligation of the lawyer is not adherence to "truth" or "justice" or the Constitution but instead to zealously represent the interests of his client. The lawyer is prohibited from lying himself or putting his client on the witness stand to knowingly lie. This obligation, however, does not prevent the lawyer from making it appear that a person testifying is lying even if the lawyer has no actual doubt of the witness' truthfulness. Remember the lawyer is not the judge nor the jury. His function is to ask questions of witnesses and to present his observations to the finder of fact. These observations are not required to be consistent with his own beliefs but must conform to his responsibility to represent the interests of his client. Am I telling you it is the responsibility of the lawyer to lie—no, not quite, but it is certainly his responsibility to pose questions in such a manner so as to make it appear that others are lying. It is a strange profession; a difficult one for non-lawyers to understand. Lawyers are trained to suggest and attempt to actually convince others of positions they often know not to be true—that is their training. The problem with our political system of today is that many highly trained lawyers have been placed in responsible positions where it is not intended that they act as lawyers. They are elected or appointed officials who presently have responsibilities to the public at large and foremost among those responsibilities is to be truthful and to act with integrity to perform their duties in accord with their Constitutional Responsibilities. Today as we watch lawyers in action (or non-action) it is clearly apparent that lawyers acting in non-lawyerly capacities are attempting to manipulate and hide the truth from the public. That is not their present job and as they continue to foment confusion and disbelief and the resultant chaos it is perhaps appropriate to remember the Shakespearean warning about the evils associated with this unique profession.
