



Yes, I could go on for the rest of the month, but there's enough to celebrate right there to make your day. And one more piece of useless information: There are 145 shopping days left till Christmas.

I came across the following somewhere or other and liked the idea so much I thought you'd like it, too:

"I have a decision I can make every morning when I wake up. I have a choice. I can spend the day in bed going through the difficulty I have with body parts that aren't working as well as they used to, or I can get out of bed and be thankful for the parts that still DO work! Each day is a gift and as long as my eyes open, I will focus on the new day and the happy memories I've stored just for this time in my life."

One day I noticed two adult Quail herding what must have been a dozen or more tiny little chicks from the cactus plant to my lemon tree and they spent the day there in the cool, damp shade. I hoped to see them the next day but they had packed their bags and moved on.



house. Alstroemeria, which are always available at my grocery store for \$3.99 a bunch. They last for over a week and thanking God that the first thing I see every morning is flowers is a great way to start the day.

It's been incredibly hot everywhere and the most delicious feeling in the world is to step out of the heat and humidity and back into our air-conditioned houses. Yes, our electric bill makes us gasp when we open it, but life is so much better with A/C than without it. John and I suffered through about 44 years of stifling, mind-numbing heat in our hun-dred-year-old house on Alegria before we were finally able to install air conditioning, which made our life so much more enjoyable.

We continually offer thanks to the fine minds who came up with air conditioning and, thanks to Wikipedia, here's something you might not know about this best invention ever: The basic concept behind A/C is said to have happened in ancient Egypt, where reeds were hung in windows and moistened with trickling water. Water evaporation cooled the air blowing through the window, which also made the air more humid, beneficial in that dry desert climate. In ancient Rome, water from aqueducts was circulated through the walls of certain houses (think mansions) to cool them. Second century Chinese inventor Ding Huan of the Han Dynasty invented a rotary fan for air conditioning with 7 wheels, 10 ft. in diameter, manually powered by prisoners. (See, it just doesn't pay to tick off the Emperor!) Cornelis Drebbel turned summer into winter for James 1st of England by adding salt to water







Annual Sidewalk Replacement Program Begins

The City's Annual Sidewalk Replacement Program began earlier this week in the southeastern portion of the City. Each year, this program replaces approximately 1 mile of sidewalk at various locations citywide. The work includes replacement of sidewalk, driveway approaches, curb ramps, and curb and gutter. Residents on impacted streets can expect to receive notices from the City's hired contractor, CJ Concrete, with additional details about the project timeline, what residents can expect during the project, and what the project's impact to the neighborhood will be. The City appreciates resident cooperation, as the sidewalk program helps improve the City's infrastructure and resident safety.

Parks & Public Works Recent Happenings

Over the past week, Parks and Public Works maintenance staff worked on the following tasks: removing fallen tree branches, palm fronds, and other debris from the public right-of-way; replacing streetlight bulbs and street signs; performing minor trimming of tree limbs and vegetation; repairing pavement and concrete; and performing various repairs at City facilities. Public Works maintenance staff also responded to multiple call-outs for fallen trees and tree limbs in the public right-of-way over the past week, and ensured the area was cleared in a safe and timely manner. On Saturday, July 15, 2023, at 6:23 a.m., according to the Ring camera of a neighboring house, Colin departed from the Clamshell Canyon trailhead above Monrovia, never to return alive, and it would be until Tuesday, July 25, 2023, that his body was found by Sierra Madre Search and Rescue.

REVIEW OF NEIL STRAUSS' EMERGENCY

In last week's column, I reviewed Morris Berman's book, "The Twilight of American Culture," where he points out that all cultures have always declined, and he saw no reason why American culture could escape that fate.

Along the way, Berman pointed out, cultures don't just go downhill, but often transform, and have ups and downs along the way. I recently gave a lecture based on this book, and I added the ideas from several other au-thors to broaden the perspective.

One entertaining book is "Emergency" by Neil Strauss, published in 2009. It's a thick book, 418 pages long, where Strauss takes us along on his survival adventure. He's a man who became very concerned that America was going to hell in a handbasket, and he didn't want to go down with the ship. He shares the facts as he sees them, and he spends the beginning of the book describing how he can find safe haven elsewhere, out of the United Stated. He takes us on his journey of off-shore banking, multiple passports, the logistics of actually getting out if there was an impending crisis. This is a man who was convinced that the U.S. was the worst place to be in the world and he was trying whatever he could to find refuge elsewhere.

That's the 25 cent version anyway. And though all of his re-search was correct, he made a fascinating and eye-opening discovery in his world travels: Wherever he went, there were people working just as hard to get INTO the U.S., as he was working to get out. Everyone wanted to come here to the United States of America. It made Strass start to re-think his whole survival plan. He decided to take another look at the United States, and see if perhaps he should set his sights closer to home.

Strauss takes us step by step in this journey, where he began to enroll in various sorts of survival classes here in the U.S., and describes his learning process. He didn't know it at the time, but he was learning how to live with less, and how to live with very little in the forest, or his own backyard for that matter.

Among the many classes he describes joining and doing his best to master, included Tom Brown Jr.'s Tracker School where he learned to make fire, make a lean-to and sleep in it, cold and rain notwithstanding. Remember, this is not a how-to book, but an entertaining book where the author explains how pathetic he felt, how vulnerable he felt in the big mean world, but by taking classes and learning hands-on, he slowly became confident in his own abilities, and his likelihood of surviving a disaster.

We're treated to a cast of characters who inhabit the "survival" world, such as firearms instructors, hard-core survivalists, the CERT training, and even me. Yes, among the many classes that Neil Strauss attended in his personal training program included the classes that I teach through the School of Self-Reliance. He described learning how to recognize wild foods, and how we created meals that we collected from the wild that day. He describes how he learned to make an archery bow from me, and how we made fire with the bow and drill. He even talks about how I eat poison oak to develop immunity – though I do not recommend it to others because our body chemistries are so different.

I barely remember Strauss at the many classes of mine he describes. He didn't say much. In fact, I only learned about his book because a friend alerted me to the fact that I was described in it. I guess I felt good that I could make someone else feel confident, and feel good about living in the United States, decline or not.

Strauss talks about how he enrolled in the CERT (Citizen Emergency Response Team) program, which is a nationwide program to get civilians trained and ready for emergencies.

Strauss talks about the training, the gear that he learned to use, and how the training altered his state of mind regarding emergencies. "Before I would run away from a problem or disaster, and now I was running to it," he explained.

Strauss also describes a self-imposed three-day survival experiment in his own home where he could use no refrigerator, no gas or electricity, and couldn't use the flush toilet. Everything had to be from the food, water, and gear he stored, and this was no small feat considering he lived in a smallish urban home.

As I said, it's not a how-to book, but it's loaded with practical experiences that anyone can adapt and apply. You can find copies on CLASSES AND BOOKS BY CHRISTOPHER NYERGES





CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ISSUES PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY PROGRAM FOR ASIAN CIT-RUS PSYLLID AND HUANGLONGBING

Between June 6, 2023 and June 30, 2023, the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) collected citrus tree tissues and insect vectors in the cities and communities in Los Angeles County, including Duarte. The CDFA was able to confirm the presence of the causative bacterial agent of the citrus disease huanglongbing (HLB) in citrus tree tissue and the insect vector Asian citrus psyllid (ACP). Due to ACP being a vector for the bacteria that causes HLB and the rapid reproductive rate of ACP, there is a high potential for ACP to establish and spread, resulting in sudden future detections of HLB/ACP in Los Angeles County cities. As a result, the California Department of Food and Agriculture has issued a Proclamation Emergency Program to carry out immediate emergency action to prevent the preceding loss and damage to California's resources.

Dear Savvy Senior:

Are there any monitored medical alert devices that you know of that don't require pushing a wearable help button? My 82-year-old father, who lives alone, has fallen twice during the past year but doesn't like wearing an SOS pendant button. Searching Daughter

Dear Searching:

Yes, there are actually several monitored medical alert systems and other tech-nologies on the market today that have voice-activated capabilities that let sen-iors call for help using voice commands, without pushing a wearable help but-ton.

These new technologies are very helpful for elderly seniors that live alone who forget, or prefer not to wear a help button, as well as for those who have physi-cal challenges that makes using a help button difficult.

By simply speaking the "wake words" these devices will connect your dad to a trained dispatcher at a 24/7 monitoring center who will find out what the prob-lem is, and get him the help he needs, whether it's calling emergency services, or contacting a fam-ily member, friend or neighbor to come and help him

All of these technologies also offer family/caregiv-er smartphone apps that will help you keep tabs on your dad from afar and notify you know if a problem oc-curs.

Hands-Free Medical Alerts

Some of the best voice-focused medical alert systems available today are GetSafe, Aloe Care Health and HandsFree Health.

Rated by U.S. News & World Report as their No. 1 medical alert system for 2023, GetSafe (GetSafe. com) comes with a cellular base console, voice-activated and push wall buttons, an optional personal help button and fall detection sensors. To call for help your dad would simply say "Call 911" twice and he would be connected to GetSafe's 24/7 monitor-ing service. Prices for GetSafe start at \$79 plus a \$30 monthly monitoring fee.

Another highly rated system is Aloe Care Health (AloeCare.com), which comes with a voice-activated Smart Hub and optional wearable help button with fall de-tection capabilities. This system would connect your dad to the Aloe Care 24/7 monitoring center by simply saying "Emergency" repeatedly until connected. It can also make voice command



nonemergency calls to preassigned contacts. Prices start at \$150 plus a monthly fee of \$30.

The WellBe by HandsFree Health (Hands-FreeHealth.com) is a nice third option to consider. This comes with the WellBe Medical Alert Speaker that would let your dad call for help by saying "OK

WellBe Call Emergency." WellBe also offers hands-free calling and messag-ing to contacts, will answer health questions, and provide reminders for medications and doctor appoint-ments. It also offers a medical alert watch and pendant (sold separately) with fall detection capabilities. WellBe starts at \$100 plus \$20/month.

Smart Home Solution

BEST MEDICAL ALERT SYSTEMS YOU DON'T HAVE TO WEAR

Instead of a traditional medical alert system, another terrific hands-free way to call for help is to get your dad an Amazon Echo device (prices range from \$50 to \$250) and sign him up for Alexa Together (Amazon.com/AlexaTogether). This is remote caregiving service that will turn his Echo into a medical alert system. To get help your dad would say "Alexa, call for help" to be connected to their 24/7 Urgent Response center.

Alexa Together, which costs \$20/month, also works with compatible third-party fall detection devices like Vayyar and AltumView. If a fall is detected, Alexa can ask your dad if he needs help, then connect him to the Urgent Response line and alert his emergency contacts.

Amazon Echo devices also provide a bevy of other features your dad may find useful. For example, Echo's will let your dad make hands-free calls, receive re-minders, set timers and alarms, control smart home devices, check the weather, play his favorite music and much more.

knows, when a loved one dies, those left behind face major challenges, not only emotionally, but financially and legally as well. Successfully navigating all those challenges becomes a necessary part of honoring the life of a loved one who's passed. Unfortunately, so many of us just aren't prepared for that eventuality when it happens.

Determining Dying's True Cost

To further shed light on just how vastly unprepared most of us are when dealing with death, in March 2022 Goldman Sachs released its first-ever "Cost of Dying Report". The report surveyed more than 2,000 Americans-each of whom had lost a loved one in the last five years-to get a clearer picture of dying's true cost to families.

The report looked not only at the financial burden dying brings, but it also examined the cost "in time, in stress, in lost productivity, and in strained interpersonal bonds." Paired with the results of the research, the Cost of Dying includes a collection of insights from the study's advisors, partners, and experts in the bereavement field.

These contributors seek to clarify what we can learn from the study's numbers and explain how we can use the figures to rethink how to best serve the bereaved, "as individuals, as organizations, and as a society." The following are some of the study's most notable findings, along with corresponding insights from some of the report's contributors.

THE FINANCIAL COST

Nationally, following a loved one's death, the total bill-including the funeral and hiring all the other professional support-cost families an average of \$12,702. The average cost of a funeral was \$7,267, and according to the National Funeral Directors Association, that cost has risen 7.6% in the last 5 years.

On top of the funeral, families paid an average of \$5,846 to hire additional professionals, such as lawyers, financial advisors, and realtors. The average bill charged for these services include the following breakdown:

Professional Services

\$4,461 real estate professionals \$3,910 lawyer fees \$2,456 accountants \$1,637 therapists or social workers

Notably, the \$3,910 in lawyer's fees was nearly doubled when estates required the court process of probate, which was the case for one-third of the families surveyed. When you include lawyers, court costs, and all the other related fees, the total cost to complete probate for families averaged \$16,800.

As anyone who has per- | Fortunately, by placing assets in a properly created and maintained revocable living trust, assets held by the trust will pass to your loved ones without the need for probate or any court intervention following your death or incapacity. And that's especially important in California, where the costs of probate are even higher than the national averages.

Paying The Final Bill

So how did families pay for all these expenses? Only 1 in 7 families had any of the costs associated with their loved ones' death paid in advance or were able to use payable-on-death funds. Additionally, more than 50% of families had to deal with estates that included debt. To foot the bill for these expenses, 36.1% of respondents used their own savings or investments, while 42.4% used their checking accounts or credit cards.

For most families, the financial costs associated with loss were exacerbated by a lack of information about exactly how much money they should expect to spend, notes internal medicine physician Shoshana Ungerleider, MD, in the report's section on death's financial cost. Compounding that stress, Ungerleider says, was the families' fear of making a mistake that would make their financial burden even worse.

"A majority of families find themselves unprepared for and under-informed about the real financial costs of death, with few available resources for finding out," writes Ungerleider. "They can spend months or years terrified that a wrong move would wipe out their inheritance or even their own savings."

As an example of what such a mistake might look like, Ungerleider notes that a lack of proper estate planning can lead to the deceased's home being seized after death "to pay off expenses incurred through Medicare, even if the family member who was their primary caregiver is still living in the home."

This is another area where thoughtful estate planning can be invaluable. It is important to ensure you and/or your senior parents can qualify for Medicare and other benefits, without putting the family home or other assets at risk.

In fact, your estate plan can - and probably should - include various asset protection tools designed to keep your financial wealth out of the hands of third parties, and responsibly in the hands of your loved ones, no matter what happens in the future.




