#### WHOOPING COUGH ALERT

Pasadena officials warned Friday that people who visited the Kidspace Children's Museum Tuesday should watch for symptoms of whooping cough after an infected resident was confirmed to have been

The resident was at the museum at 480 N. Arroyo Blvd. between 1:30 p.m. and 5 p.m., Pasadena spokeswoman Lisa Derderian said. Whooping cough, also known as Pertussis, is a bacterial illness that can spread easily, according to the Mayo Clinic. Many sufferers get a serious hacking cough. Inhaling after coughing often causes a high-pitched noise that sounds like a ``whoop."

Cold-like symptoms usually appear five to 21 days after exposure and there can be a low-grade fever of less than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, Derderian said. ``If you were at Kidspace Childrens Museum during this time frame, you and your family should monitor for symptoms in your household, especially in children, for up to 21 days.'

Anyone who develops symptoms should contact their health care provider and remain at home until cleared by a doctor or after five days of antibiotic treatment, she said.

Many babies with the illness don't cough at all, the Mayo Clinic said. Some babies and young children might gag or struggle to breathe, have skin, lips or nails that turn blue or purple or have life-threatening pauses in breathing called apnea.

For infants under the age of 1, their caregivers and pregnant women may need preventive antibiotics if they were exposed, Derderian said. It can be prevented by the Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap) shot and boosters, she said.

The Pasadena Public Health Department offers the vaccines by appointment.

#### **DON'T JUDGE A BOOK BY ITS COVER**

Library Renovations are More than Meets the Eye

It may appear as if nothing is happening at 440 W Sierra Madre Boulevard. Peeking through the construction fence shows a glimpse of dirt, some heavy equipment, and the mid-century design building still intact. However, it is what's happening on the inside that counts. While keeping the outer shell of the Library, the interior has been stripped down to the studs, but will soon be built back up better than ever!

The Sierra Madre Public Library received \$10,669,210 in state and federal grant funding to accommodate a 5,000 square foot expansion, ADA and seismic upgrades, improved green space, new HVAC, new electrical, new plumbing, asbestos abatement, window replacement, and the addition

With rising costs over the last few years, grant funding did not cover the total cost of renovating the Library. The City of Sierra Madre decided to allocate \$1.8 Million from the city's reserve funds to ensure the Library Meaningful Improvement Project could proceed with construction.

The \$12,499,210 available for the renovation's design and construction portions does not cover the furniture, fixtures, and equipment (FF&E) needed for the interior of the building. Thankfully, local non-profit organizations and the community itself have stepped in to help.

In June 2023, the Friends of the Sierra Madre Library pledged \$400,000 from the Mary Tumilty fund, \$145,000 from the Partners' fund and \$150,000 from their general fund to go toward FF&E costs. Starting our interior fundraising with \$695,000, what a wonderful way to start!

The Sierra Madre Historical Preservation Society has donated proceeds from programs to support the library's FF&E goals. In addition, to the generous pledge from the Friends of the Library and sponsored programs from the Historical Preservation Society, Robert S. Day created a trust for the Library. Effective January 2020, the Library receives \$25,000 per year for capital or operating costs.



To date, the trust has grown to \$125,000, which the Library intends to use for FF&E needs. This brings the starting total to \$820,000 for purchasing all interior needs like desks, tables, chairs, computers, shelves, and more.

The Sierra Madre Library Foundation continues to work steadfastly to raise more funds for the library's furniture, fixtures, and equipment. The Library Foundation is helping to provide our community with a 21st Century library that will be a vital space for civic engagement for generations to come.

We are deeply saddened to share the passing of Ann Erdman yesterday, surrounded by love. She was embraced by her daughter, Jessica, and Jessica's wife, Trina, with Ella Fitzgerald's Misty playing in the

background—an atmosphere of grace and warmth that reflected Ann herself.



Ann dedicated decades to public service, managing the Public Affairs Office for the City of Pasadena since 1991. With integrity and transparency, she shaped communication in Pasadena, serving as a trusted voice to the media, the mayor, city council, and countless residents. Dubbed the "Minister of Truthiness" by the \*Pasadena Weekly\*, Ann set the standard for honesty and clarity in her work. After retiring in 2012, she continued to lend her talents to nonprofits, including the Pasadena Senior Center, where we were privileged to have her expertise, even if our resources never matched her worth. Regardless, she gave her all—telling stories with precision, grace, and unwavering commitment. She was a true professional, but beyond that, she was a joyful soul, a woman of faith, and someone who faced challenges with humor and determination.

Ann wasn't just a master of public affairs; she embraced Pasadena's culture with unparalleled enthusiasm. Having worked under former Palm Springs Mayor Sonny Bono, she brought her deep expertise to Pasadena, where she became an integral part of its traditions—both grand and unconventional. In 2012, she made local history as the first person to ride in both the Rose Parade and its wildly spirited counterpart, the Doo Dah Parade. But her Doo Dah involvement started long before that. Over the years, she took on roles ranging from Dorothy from \*The Wizard of Oz\* to Elvis, a baby in a giant high chair, a captain of industry, and even a motorcycle mama. No matter the costume or occasion, Ann never said no-because, as she put it, "if there's one thing I think I have, it's guts."

And guts she had. Ann faced numerous illnesses over the years, yet through it all, she relied on her faith, humor, and the unwavering support of her family and friends to carry her forward. She fought to stay alive, and her resilience was a testament to her spirit. The family has not announced the cause of her passing, but what remains clear is her legacy—a life lived fully, courageously, and with deep dedication to the community she loved.

## WHAT'S NEW IN HEALTHCARE IN LOS ANGELES: HOUSE CALLS ARE BACK, BRINGING BETTER ACCESS AND IMPROVED OUTCOMES

In Los Angeles County, residents are now enjoying something reminiscent of older classic television shows, harkening back to simpler times. Remember the old Marcus Welby, MD TV show? The doctor, with a kind bedside manner, made house calls and was on a firstname basis with many of his patients. After his examination, he would console the family and announce, "Don't worry, she'll be just fine."

But what's old is new again as actual house calls are making a comeback, providing better access and improved outcomes here in Los Angeles County.

Many older adults are now benefiting from programs being offered through many health insurers who bring nurse practitioners and their preventive care skills into the homes of older adults. The nurse practitioners spend up to an hour with patients, checking their health and helping them make connections to other social services so they can live a better, more independent life.

Los Angeles County is faring about the same as the average county in California for Population Health and Well-being, and better than the average county in the nation according to County Health Rankings & Roadmaps, a national study operated by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation. In Los Angeles County, California, 29% of adults reported that they consider themselves in fair or poor health, compared to 18% for California.

One nurse practitioner who is a true believer of home house calls them has seen firsthand how the program is saving lives. She describes it as putting out fires before they ever start.

She fondly talks about Jack as an example of how the program is making a difference. One day, after Jack had finished doing his chores, he noticed that he was breathing a little hard. It worsened when he went inside the house. Fortunately, his nurse practitioner was due for her visit to see Jack. She immediately noticed something wasn't right when Jack's blood pressure shot up dangerously high, at 217/110. She insisted that he go to the doctor and receive care. Jack admitted that if she hadn't come over, he wouldn't have gone to the doctor, saying, "They found my widow maker, my vein to my heart, and it was 97% clogged." The doctor placed a stent in his heart, preventing a massive heart attack. He calls his nurse practitioner his "guardian angel." Jack credits his nurse practitioner for saving his life.

Colleen, another nurse practitioner who makes house calls, likes to get to know her patients by visiting them regularly in their homes. During a recent visit with her patient, Sue, she sensed there was a problem right away. Sue was having bad pain in the back of her calf — to the point where she couldn't walk. Colleen performed a pain assessment and used a screening tool to measure the blood flow to Sue's legs and feet. The screening showed Sue had poor circulation in her leg that, if left untreated, could have resulted in serious complications, potentially leading to the loss of her leg. Colleen sought proper medical attention immediately, which not only saved Sue's life but also saved her independence.

Harkening back to house calls is something old that's new again and improving the lives of older adults.

In response to the needs of older adults affected by the recent Eaton Fire, Los Angeles County is hosting a special workshop to support residents aged 62 and older who hold reverse mortgages and are facing property damage or loss.

The workshop will help participants take the first steps to better understand their existing reverse mortgage agreements and the financial and legal implications tied to disaster-related property damage.




The event will take place on Saturday, May 10, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at MonteCedro Senior Living Community, located at 2212 El Molino Avenue, Altadena, CA 91001. Spanish and Armenian translation services will be available to ensure broader access for attendees.

A group workshop will be led by Aimee Williams, Associate Vice President of Justice for Tenants, Homeowners, and Unhoused Individuals at Bet Tzedek Legal Services. Ms. Williams will provide critical guidance and answer questions related to reverse mortgages in the context of disaster recovery. There will also be representatives from various housing and legal services agencies—including the Federal Housing Administration, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and pro bono legal private firms-on hand to help with more individualized consultations.

Then there's Rocco's Tavern on Green Street. A true sports bar. Big screens, louder regulars, and some of the best pizza in Pasadena. Rocco's knows what to do when a local team goes down: serve better food, pour colder drinks, and talk up the next thing — right now, that's just the Clippers, the Kings are done too, so it's the Clippers keeping hope flickering.

The truth is, these bars don't close up when the buzzer sounds. They adapt. They get creative. They remind us that sometimes the game is just an excuse — the real draw is the company and what's on the plate.

I'm reminded of something my dad used to say — and he knew a little about restaurants: "If you're only good when there's a crowd, you're not that good."

So yes, the Lakers are out. But in L.A., the game is never really over.

Not when the pizza's hot, the Clippers are still alive, and there's always someone at the bar wondering, "What are we watching tonight?" Well There is always the Peter Dills podcast!!

#### JOURNEY BEYOND DESPAIR

Back in the late 1970s, I met Julie Parker while working as a typesetter for the old Altadena Chronicle, which later became the Altadena Weekly. Julie was one of the writers there and I recognized her as a thinker who seemed ahead of her time.

Now, decades later, she is sharing her book about her own life.



In her new memoir, where she defines herself as one of the San Gabriel Valley's oldest married couples, "Journey Beyond Despair" addresses the question: Can mental illness be a gift to a relationship? The subtitle is "A memoir of Love, Psychosis, and the Power of Insight. The memoir represents a startling voice which offers hope to sufferers and their families and support teams.

As I read through the book, I found a compelling story and lots of solutions. The book is Julie Parker describes her book as "a true story of two lovers pitted against a deadly enemy, Journey Beyond Despair, a Memoir of Love, Psychosis and the Power of Insight, introduces Julie, the quixotic author, whose conflict between lofty ideals and earthly reality results in mental illness. The book opens in 1960 as Peter delivers Julie, his terrified wife to a Chicago psychiatric hospital, then returns home to pick up the pieces with

three tiny daughters. Julie has been his sweetheart from college days, idealizing his grounded maturity."

It's great reading, and by reading the table of contents alone, you'll see the path of her life. As Julie slowly recovers, the saga follows her 36 year resolve to outwit this illness. She writes, "Determination to become the dependable partner Peter and the family deserve rouses her greatest fear: intimacy. She soars into escapist projects each time the family transfers to new territory, then relapses. Fear of losing all she cherishes drives the author to search to the core of her own flawed nature. Peter supports this inward battle, but when the quest swallows his mate into Eastern philosophy, it is too much for him. The two lovers despair. At the defining moment, however, Julie's insight and Peter's selflessness combine to spark a stunning twist neither foresees. Together, the two 'crack the code' of mental illness, showing its healing potential and lifting Julie's search for meaning to the realm of mythic/heroic journey."

In discussing this book, Julie told me, "Beyond despair lies transformative healing; that has been my experience. I want to encourage sufferers to frame their lives as journeys with a beautiful end goal, not a chronic disorder requiring the right diagnosis and medication. These can surely help, but my particular healing followed a definite 12 stage 'mythic journey' (I realized, later) as outlined in Christopher Vogler's The Writer's Journey (the bible for screen writers hoping to get into film.) Vogler based his book upon Joseph Campbell's The Hero with a Thousand Faces. I'd like to give workshops on this subject: Framing one's life as a heroic/mythic journey." Indeed! I'd love to attend such a workshop.


Parker points out that mental illness symptoms are surging today, as there is a reliance on diagnosis and medication. Her mission with this book is show the insight of the sufferer, which is often ignored. Also important is a devoted support team. Parker makes a case for the small, psychiatric hospitals that have all but vanished today in favor of drugs and "72 hour holds" that send deeply disturbed patients back into society instead of giving them a place apart and time to slowly recuperate.

"Journey Beyond Despair" is a thoughtful book where Parker shares her most personal issues, in a way that makes you think. I never knew any of this when I worked with Parker in the 1970s, but reading it today makes me realize that you can never know what another is experiencing, and one should always do their best to be kind to everyone.

Julie and Peter, now aged ninety-two and ninety-four, are on a mission to share their message with hospitals, counseling centers, book clubs, libraires, book stores and church groups. Journey Beyond Despair could even be of interest to college psychology classes as one unusual case

A graduate of Middlebury College and the University of Paris in 1954, Julie taught French and led yoga sessions for 40 years. She also has an M.A. in Marriage, Family Therapy, 1992, and created a teen relationships program for thousands in Pasadena, California's public schools from 1997 to 2006. 



#### DOES MEDICARE COVER VISION CARE AND EYE EXAMS?

Dear Savvy Senior,

What all does Medicare cover when it comes to vision care? *I currently have good vision insurance through my employer* but will lose it when I retire.

Dear Almost,

Many soon-to-be retirees are a bit blurry with what Medicare does and doesn't cover when it comes to vision care. The good news is that Medicare covers most medical issues like cataract surgery, treatment of eye diseases and medical emergencies. But unfortunately, routine care like eye exams and eyeglasses are usually the beneficiary's responsibility. Here's a breakdown of what is and isn't covered.

Eye exams and treatments: Medicare does not cover routine eye exams that test for eyeglasses or contact lenses, but they do cover yearly medical eye exams if you have diabetes or are at high risk for glaucoma. They will also pay for exams to test and treat medical eye diseases if you're having vision problems that indicate a serious eye problem like macular degeneration, dry eye syndrome, glaucoma, eye infections or if you get something in your eye.

Eye surgeries: Medicare will cover most eye surgeries that help repair the eye function, including cataract surgery to remove cataracts and insert standard intraocular lenses to replace your own. Medicare will not, however, pick up the extra cost if you choose a premium multifocal lens that restores full range of vision, thereby reducing your need for glasses after cataract surgery. The extra cost for a premium lens can run \$1,500 to \$4,000 per eye.

Eye surgeries that are usually not covered by Medicare include refractive (LASIK) surgery and cosmetic eye surgery that are not considered medically necessary.

Eyeglasses and contact lenses: Medicare will not pay for eyeglasses or contact lenses, with one exception: If you have had a conventional intraocular lens inserted during cataract surgery, Medicare will pay for eyeglasses or contact lenses following the operation.

Ways to Save

Although original Medicare's vision coverage is limited to medical issues, there are ways you can save on routine care. Here are several to check into.

Medicare Advantage plans: Many of these plans, which are alternatives to original Medicare and sold through private insurance companies, cover routine eye exams and eyeglasses, but coverage is limited so be sure you understand the specifics.

While I don't recommend enrolling in an Advantage plan just to get vision coverage it is an option you should know about. To locate Advantage plans in your area that provide vision coverage, go to Medicare.gov/plan-compare or call 800-633-4227.

Purchase vision insurance: If you get routine eye exams and purchase new eyeglasses annually, a vision insurance plan may be worth the costs. These policies typically range between \$5 and \$30 per month. Most plans will also have copays or deductibles you'll be responsible for.

Check veterans' benefits: If you're a veteran and qualify for VA health care benefits, you may be able to get some or all of your routine vision care through VA. Go to VA.gov/health-care/about-va-healthbenefits/vision-care to learn more.

Find cheaper shopping options: Many retailers provide discounts – between 10 and 50 percent – on eye exams and eyeglasses if you belong to a MEMBERSHIP GROUP LIKE AARP OR AAA.

You can also save by shopping at discount retailers like Costco Optical, Sam's Club Optical or Target Optical, which are all recommended by Consumer Reports. Or consider buying your glasses online at retailers like ZenniOptical.com, EyeBuyDirect.com or GlassesUSA.com which offer big savings.

To purchase glasses online, you'll need a valid prescription from an eye doctor (no more than a year old), plus your pupillary distance number, which is the distance, measured in millimeters, between the centers of your pupils in each eye.

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

I was sitting in the shopping mall, drinking coffee and taking a break. I don't like going to the mall, but sometimes I have to go and pick up something for The Gracious Mistress of the Parsonage. Sometimes, I think she does it on purpose, knowing how much I

While drinking coffee, I watched people pass by. I can't understand why so many people like coming to the mall.

Suddenly, I saw someone I recognized—or at least, I thought I recognized. It was my great-aunt. That would be my grandmother's sister, who passed away about 25 years ago. How could she be in the mall here today? Or, is it her ghost?

Staring at her as she walked by, I couldn't help but believe she was either my

great-aunt or an identical substitute. Everything about her reminded me of my

I haven't thought about my great-aunt for many years. She's been deceased now for 25 years. Sitting there thinking about her, many things came to mind.

The first thing was that she was the biggest gossiper in the whole town. It was a small town, but she knew everything that was happening there.

Her job was delivering mail, and she would stop at my grandmother's mailbox daily. They would catch up on a lot of things. Together, they both knew everything that ever happened or would happen in that little town.

I couldn't help but chuckle as I thought of the stories associated with her. I never told her or my grandmother that I referred to her as Ms. Gossips-A-Lot. I'm unsure where the name came from; I just made it up. But if anybody knew how to gossip, it was her.

It was always a wonderful time to sit down with my great-aunt and listen to the stories she told. I never knew if those stories were true, but she presented them to me, and at the time, I believed them to be true. All I had to do was mention a name, and she would go on and on about that person. She knew more about that person than that person probably did. And the critical aspect is that she knew where all the dead bodies were buried, so to speak. People couldn't get the daily gossip they once did and didn't realize how much they depended upon Auntie's gossip.

I've written about Kilmar Abrego Garcia, the Maryland dad deported to El Salvador through what the Trump administration admits was a mistake. The Supreme Court ordered

the government to "facilitate" his return while the White House claims it's out of their hands.

There's another aspect to the story that hasn't gotten much attention. According to The Atlantic, when officials first became aware of Abrego Garcia's deportation, things actually began to work as they were supposed to. Responding to a lawsuit filed by Abrego Garcia's family, career employees at the Departments of Justice, State and Homeland Security realized this had to be taken care of and then proceeded to try and get it taken care of.

DHS attorneys, aware the deportation violated a court order, worked through diplomatic channels to have Abrego Garcia returned – as they'd done in similar cases before. But this time, they were stopped - not by any resistance from the Salvadoran government, but by the White House.

For Trump's team, there was never intent to rectify a mistake and/or comply with an order from our highest court. The whole purpose was to show how they could get away with disappearing somebody to a foreign prison without any pretense of due process - with nobody, including the courts, able to do anything about it.

El Salvador's President Bukele played along during his Oval Office meeting with the president, insisting he had no intention of releasing Abrego Garcia - so thered be no point in Trump trying to bring him home, anyway. When Sen. Chris Van Hollen (D-MD) met with Salvadoran Vice President Ulloa

in El Salvador, however, the message was entirely different. According to Sen. Van Hollen, Vice President Ulloa made clear the only reason they were holding Abrego Garcia was because the U.S. was paying them to do it – and all Trump had to do was ask for him back.

When Attorney General Pam Bondi was asked about compliance with court orders, she ended the discussion with, "President Bukele said he was not sending him back. That's the end of the story." They'd gotten away with it, and nobody could do anything about it.

As a warning to anyone who might still regard the Judiciary as a "separate but equal" branch of our government, the administration is making an example of 65-year-old Circuit Judge Hannah Dugan of Wisconsin. The narrative varies depending on the telling, but it involves a Mexican national up before Judge Dugan on battery charges.

With a task force of ICE, FBI and DEA waiting outside the courtroom for the defendant, Judge Dugan told them they'd need a judicial warrant and advised they speak with the chief judge of Milwaukee County. She led the defendant through a door into a public hallway where members of the task force were hanging out. He then got into an elevator with his attorney and one of the task force members. The others got into another elevator, which stopped at another floor to exit on the other side of the building.

The task force members went around the building and arrested the defendant. Judge Dugan was then arrested herself and charged with two felonies - obstruction and "concealing an individual from arrest" – facing six years in prison and a \$350,000

Former judge Andrew Napolitano explained on Newsmax that

the agents didn't have an arrest warrant, only an administrative warrant 'which is basically one ICE agent authorizing another ICE agent to detain someone." He said the judge has the authority "to decide how a person leaves her courtroom", but "Because they're on a bit of a jihad against judges, they decided to make an example out of this."

Authorities would normally go to a judge's own lawyer, explain that charges were about to be filed and arrange for a voluntary surrender. But instead, Judge Dugan was arrested on the street, handcuffed and perp-walked in front of the cameras.

Whether guilty or not, the one person who might've already screwed the case for the prosecution is FBI Director Kash Patel. He couldn't help tweeting out a pic of Judge Dugan in cuffs and his own opinion that "the Judge's obstruction created increased danger to the public".

In the DOJ's Justice Manual section on "Concerns of Prejudice", it bars expressing things like "Any opinion as to the defendant's guilt", and warns to "not voluntarily disclose a photograph of the defendant". Director Patel deleted his tweet soon after its posting – though it might've been up long enough to have the case thrown out.

A successful prosecution of Judge Dugan was not the point, however. The objective was to have that picture of her being perp-walked in handcuffs posted for all to see – especially by other judges who might be going up against this administration.

Our Executive Branch now consists of those who place loyalty to Trump over our Constitution. The Legislative is content to let Trump rule through Executive Order (until the mid-terms, anyway). Now by ignoring court orders and threatening those serving in the Judicial Branch, Trump is going for the trifecta.



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
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
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#### DANGERS OF RAPID **WEIGHT LOSS**

When people decide to lose weight, they usually want it to happen fast. It's exciting to see numbers drop on the scale. But losing weight too quickly can actually be dangerous for your body and your health. Even though it's great to see fast results, the truth is that slow and steady weight loss is much safer, and it leads to better long-term success.

One of the biggest problems with rapid weight loss is muscle loss. When you drop a lot of weight in a short time, your body doesn't just burn fat — it also breaks down muscle. Losing muscle might not seem like a big deal at first, but it is. Muscle is important because it keeps your metabolism working properly. Metabolism is the process your body uses to turn food into energy. The more muscle you have, the more calories your body burns even when you're just sitting still. If you lose muscle, your metabolism slows down, which makes it easier to gain the weight

back later. You might end up in a cycle of losing weight fast, then gaining it back even

Another serious risk of rapid weight loss is gallstones. Gallstones are small, hard lumps that form in the gallbladder, a small organ near your liver. They can cause a lot of pain, especially if they block the flow of bile, which helps your body digest fat. People who lose weight very quickly are at a much higher risk of developing gallstones. Sometimes, gallstones get so bad surgery is needed to remove the gallbladder. This is definitely not something you want to deal with when you're trying to get healthier.

Rapid weight loss can also cause problems with getting enough important nutrients. Many crash diets or extreme eating plans cut out entire food groups or limit calories so much that it's almost impossible to get all the vitamins and minerals your body needs. This can lead to all sorts of problems like feeling tired all the time, getting sick more easily, losing hair, and even damaging your bones over time. Your body needs a variety of healthy foods — fruits, vegetables, whole grains, protein, and healthy fats — to work properly. Skipping meals, starving yourself, or cutting out important foods can hurt you much more than a few extra pounds ever could.

Your heart can also be affected by fast weight loss. Big changes in your weight can put extra stress on your heart and make it work harder than it should. This is especially risky for people who already have heart problems, high blood pressure, or diabetes. Even if you feel fine at first, sudden weight loss can make it harder for your heart to keep up. Your heart depends on a steady balance of fluids and minerals to pump blood properly. When you lose weight fast, it has to work harder to maintain blood pressure and circulation.

There's also a mental side to losing weight too quickly. Quick weight loss plans can lead to mood swings, depression, anxiety, and unhealthy relationships with food. Some people become obsessed with the number on the scale and start to tie their self-worth to it. Others end up binging on food after a period of extreme dieting, which can lead to feelings of guilt and shame. This rollercoaster isn't good for mental health and makes it harder to stick with healthy habits over time.

Our bodies aren't made to change overnight. Real, lasting weight loss takes time. Most experts agree that losing about one to two pounds a week is a safe and realistic goal. It might not sound thrilling but losing just one pound a week adds up to over fifty pounds in a year. That's a huge change. One you're much more likely to keep.

Instead of focusing only on the scale, it's better to think about building habits that will last a lifetime. Eating a variety of healthy foods, moving your body regularly, getting enough sleep, managing stress, and drinking enough water are all part of the big picture. When you take care of your body in a balanced way, weight loss becomes a welcome side effect of getting healthier.

If you're trying to lose weight, be patient with yourself. Celebrate small victories like having more energy, getting more restful sleep, or noticing that your clothes fit better. Those signs mean your body is getting stronger and healthier, even if the changes on the scale are slow. Remember, the goal isn't just to lose weight. The goal is to build a body and a life you can enjoy for many years to come.

#### THOREAU'S CODE FOR LIFE: **WEEK TWO - ENDEAVORING**

Previously, we began exploring Thoreau's code: "If one advances confidently in the direction of their dreams, endeavoring to live the life they imagined, they meet with a success unexpected in common hours." Notice how Thoreau's code is rich with action words. "Advance" tells us to go forward in the direction of our dreams. It means move-

-you've got to start somewhere. You've got to take action, that first step.

And how do we move? "Confidently," Thoreau tells us, But this week, let's focus on another powerful verb in his code: "endeavoring."

The Art of Endeavoring

To endeavor means to make an earnest attempt—to strive toward achieving a goal. It acknowledges something profound about the human journey of becoming: we're often attempting things we've never done before, which means we have to manage unfamiliar feelings along the way.

You might feel fear as you endeavor. But what meaning will you attach to that fear? Rather than thinking, "This means I should stop" or "This means I'm in danger," consider a different interpretation: "This means I'm growing. This means I'm doing something new. This means I'm on the path

What if that flutter in your stomach isn't fear at all, but excitement? What if you spoke to yourself in a supportive, loving way that offers a fresh perspective on managing your feelings around taking

Managing the Feedback Loop

Another feeling we must manage as we endeavor is our response to what we often label as "failure"—when things don't go as expected, hoped, or planned. Rather than focusing on the result and calling it a failure, what if we viewed it differently?

This is feedback. This is simply information telling me what doesn't work. Let it act as guidance, encouraging me to try another approach. This is intelligence keeping me on the path.

Keeping Your Eyes on the Prize

As we endeavor toward our dreams, it's vital that we train ourselves to keep our eyes on the finish line while simultaneously enjoying the journey. Find happiness in remaining in action. Decide to enjoy the person you're becoming along the way.

Thoreau's philosophy isn't just about reaching some distant goal—it's about the transformation that occurs while endeavoring. The unexpected success comes not just from achieving your dreams but also from who you become through your efforts.

Notice when fear or hesitation arises as you take action. Reframe it: "This feeling means I'm growing.'

When something doesn't work out as planned, practice saying: "This is valuable feedback, not






